

Fellowships & Funding Thresholds

If your student has received an internal or external fellowship, please use the following guidelines to determine how the fellowship can be set-up and what it can pay. Remember, the following:

- 1 The **fellowship award letter and/or contract, agreement** is the first stop in determining how, and on what costs, the funding needs to be disbursed. In rare instances, external fellowship funds are used to set-up a GRA.
- 2 **Out of State Waivers** must be requested (<https://grad.gatech.edu/out-state-waiver-requests>) and are capped by USG policy (e.g., no more than 140)
- 3 A fellowship student receiving an **Out of State Waiver**, or fellowship funds to pay tuition, are considered 'full fellowship' students.
- 4 A full fellowship student **cannot simultaneously be hired as a GRA/GTA** in any given semester, but you can use the 'hourly GA' hiring mechanism to supplement, or you can toggle back and forth between 'full fellowship' and GRA/GTA.
- 5 All fellowship students must be **enrolled full-time** for funds to be disbursed. Full-time enrollment is 12 hours with at least nine of those hours taken on a letter-grade or pass/fail basis.

If funding for one academic year (e.g., F8, Sp, Su) is... Set-up as...

Up to ~\$10K	Topper	If the fellowship award is up to ~\$10,000 per academic year then the fellowship may be disbursed as a 'topper' or 'topping fellowship.' This level of funding can be combined with GRA, GTA or other full fellowship.

At least ~\$64K, an <u>Out of State Waiver</u> is approved and you'll pay a competitive stipend	\$ 64,019.40 Tuition <u>with Out of State/Country Waiver</u> , mandatory fees, health insurance, and \$37K stipend	Stipends rates vary. A fellowship student can earn more or equal to their peers. If possible, we recommend that a fellowship student does not earn less than her/his peers. For reference, the NSF GRFP annual stipend rate is \$37K and can be used as a benchmark. No simultaneous GRA/GTA.									
At least ~\$88K, Full tuition (OOSW is not needed, or not approved), and you'll pay a competitive stipend	\$ 88,292.40 Full tuition, mandatory fees, health insurance, and \$37K stipend	If the fellowship award is up to ~\$86K, an Out of State Waiver is not needed, or not approved, then funds can be used to pay full tuition, mandatory fees, health insurance and a stipend. No simultaneous GRA/GTA.									
Up to ~\$100K	\$ 101,292.40 Full tuition, mandatory fees, health insurance, and rec. max. stipend of \$50K	Some fellowships have high award amounts. OOSWs are not used in these cases and we recommend a stipend of no more than \$50K annually. No simultaneous GRA/GTA.

Sometimes external 'fellowship' funding is used to hire a student as a GRA (as a supplement to an existing GRA)

- 1 Hire the student as a GRA, tuition remission (calculated as GRA monthly rate * \$1557) is charged to the grant.
- 2 Work with GT Bursar to have the external funds brought to GT, and create worktag
- 3 Utilize the Fellowship Payment Request form process with Bursar & Financial Aid.
