

How to Award President's Fellowship in SLATE

Please see below for information on deadlines and instructions on how to **award the**<u>President's Fellowship</u> (**PF**). We will process funded PhD applicants as priority throughout the admissions cycle for fall term. For your reference, beginning in the fall 2022 admissions cycle, the Office of Graduate Education updated our PF award process to allow for more flexibility and timeliness in awarding PF's. This process allows departments to move forward as aggressively as possible to recruit the best doctoral students.

Fall 2025 Deadlines:


PF's should be awarded as early as possible and on a rolling basis.

Instructions:

1. Department sends funding offer
The funding offer, sent by departments, should include <u>all</u> funding, including the \$5,500/academic year for the PF and the following language:

"Georgia Tech's prestigious Presidential Fellowship provides an additional stipend of \$5,500 per academic year. Eligibility, maintenance and renewal criteria can be found on our <u>website</u> and questions may be directed to the Office of Graduate Education's Fellowships team at fellowships@grad.gatech.edu."

2. Department admits in SLATE & marks student as 'Award PF'
The department admits the student in SLATE and under "Funding & Advising" chooses
from the "Fellowship Nomination" drop down and selects "Award President's Fellowship
(PFs)". Screenshot:



3. Graduate Admissions staff completes admissions processing

OGE Admissions staff will complete the admission processing by verifying documents, etc. and move the student to the appropriate SLATE 'bin' when complete.

4. Graduate Fellowship Manager releases congratulatory letter

The OGE Graduate Fellowship Manager will go into SLATE several times per week to release the congratulatory letter from President Cabrera with further information re: PF award. The letter will be attached to the students SLATE record. See below for sample screenshot:
